How to disengage the rear 4 passenger bench seat latching lever



- To remove the rear seat row in a Sprinter passenger van is similar to the 2 front rows.
- Locate the two holes in the latching lever and insert a 90° bend needle nose pliers.
- Rotate pliers towards you. The latching lever will disengage.
